Title: The Spirit at Your Workplace

Introduction

1. Your Work is a Divine Calling (Ex. 31:2-4)

"See, I have called by name Bezalel... and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, understanding, knowledge, and all kinds of skills."

- Stop calling your job "just a job", you are a Spirit-filled worker in a post God assigned

2. Spirit's Gifts Include Creativity & Craftsmanship (Ex. 31:3-5)

"with all kinds of skills... to make artistic designs... to cut and set stones... to work in wood, and to engage in all kinds of crafts."

- God's Spirit gives skill, patience and excellence.
- Don't despise "blue-collar" gifts. Your hands are holy.

3. Your Work Serves the Mission of God (Ex. 35:5,10)

"Take from among you an offering to the Lord... every skilful person in whom the Lord has given skill and understanding."

- Money as a sacred offering, not just personal assets
- Skills as divine endowments for mission, not just career tools
- Money & skills work together for God's mission
