**Title:** Beyond Vineyard: Mission to the Unseen

---

## Introduction

God's mission reaches out to people who are forgotten, ignored, or left out. It brings them into a community where they are respected, treated equally, and given a place to belong.

1. **Mission means going out.** The vineyard owner goes again and again to the marketplace to look for workers. In the same way, the church cannot wait for people to come to it. It must go beyond familiar and comfortable places and look for those who are still waiting at the edges of society.
2. **Mission means seeing people others do not see.** The workers hired last were still waiting because "no one had hired" them. God sees people whom society often misses and hears voices that are often ignored. Mission is not only about helping people. It is also about recognising their dignity, their gifts, and their place as partners in God's work.
3. **Mission means restoring dignity and belonging.** When the vineyard owner gives the last workers a full day's wage, he shows that they have equal worth and that their needs matter. God's vineyard is a place of grace. A person's value is not based on productivity, status, seniority, or privilege. In God's vineyard, everyone matters and everyone has a place.

## Conclusion

This parable calls the church to keep going out, to seek people who are often overlooked, and to build communities where everyone is welcomed, valued, and invited to take part in God's mission.
